List Of Examination Reforms

- A. Examination procedures: As an affiliated college final examination are conducted by Gujarat University, for that students have to go to the allotted examination center and practical exam venue, practical exams centers can be in other dental colleges which are affiliated to university. This examination system actually provides students real competition to other college students. As per DCI guidelines internal marks are given to UG students. Internal marks are part of Reforms in Examination. Internal examinations are conducted only in college campus.
- **B.** Processes integrating IT: During internal examinations, examinations halls are equipped with CCTV camera so they are under direct surveillance during internal theory examination. During COVID 19 Pandemic, internal exams were conducted online via WebEx /Google meet platform and also by using Google forms by some department.
- C. Continuous assessment system: Three internal examinations are carried out for undergraduates. One mock examination is carried out for post -graduate students. Apart from this term end assessment during clinical postings via term end viva/ Written examinations are taken and students are also graded or marked in their record book/Journal for exercises.
- **D.** Competency based Assessment: For UG in preclinical conservative department Clinical skills/Competency are tested by assessing the student's exercises on phantom heads.
- **E. OSCE/OSPE:** Every Department is implementing OSCE/OSPE policy from 2021 onwards for the internal evaluation of students during their term end or terminal exam/ prelim exam.
