

# REPORT OF SPORTS AND CULTURAL

## ACTIVITIES

### 2016

The institute organizes garba, cultural and sports activities for the students every year. Mrudang - the Garba festival is celebrated every year as a one-day event. The sports and cultural activities are scheduled as a weekly celebration in the institute. These events are organized by the students in co-ordination with the cultural and sports committee of the institute.

For the year 2016, the committee decided to celebrate various events under the heading of **Occlusion 2016**. Occlusion 2016 celebration was planned and the weeks were scheduled for the cultural and sports activities.

**Mrudang 2016**, the garba event was organized in the month of Navratri on 7.10.2016. The venue of this event was the college lawn.
