
REPORT ON FEEDBACK RECEIVED FROM STUDENTS •



1. ENTIRE SYLLABUS COVERED AS PRESCRIBED BY THE UNIVERSITY





2. The Content of the course was relevant





3. Ability to integrate topics beyond curriculum to provide broader perspective for career enhancement.





4. When you meet a student who has undergone similar program from outside the institute, your program was superior/inferior in terms of theoretical/clinical content.





5. Facilities provided in terms of infrastructure & audio visuals aids.





6. Availabilities beyond normal classis & cooperation to solve individual problems





7. Knowledge gained after completion of courses





8. Fairness in Evalution in assessment/internals






10. Time adequacy provided for the completion of course
