Indian Academy of Sports Dentistry: Reaches a New Milestone!

IASD aligns with international standards set by the World Dental Federation (FDI) underscoring our commitment to advancing sports dentistry in India



Sports Dentists from Indian Academy of Sports Dentistry (IASD)- IDA HO successfully evaluated the oral health status of elite swimmers from Gujarat at the Savvy Swara] Sports Club Complex in Gota, Ahmedabad, hosted by the Gujarat District Swimming Association. Their mission was to address the unique oral health issues of swimmers, such as tooth erosion, calculus, and staining, which arise from prolonged exposure to chlorinated water. These issues are not just local concerns but have also been significant at global

events like the Olympics, where dental issues rank as the second most common medical request among athletes.

91 swimmers and 6 coaches & parents underwent comprehensive oral examinations at the screening and education stations set up at the venue. Detailed education and prevention strategies were provided to the athletes, coaches and parents. Oral hygiene kits were distributed and pH studies of pool and athlete's oral cavity provided significant insights into the prevailing issues amongst swimmers. Mr. Virendra Nanavati, the first Indian Bureau member of the International Swimming Federation, and Mr. Kamlesh Nanavati, Vice President of the Swimming Federation of India graced the program. This event was led by sports dentists Dr Kunjal Patel and Dr Sanket Shroff from the IASD with 17 volunteers from Government Dental College and Hospital Ahmedabad with the guidance of Dr Reena Kumar and Dr. Atul Surve. Support from Dean Dr Rupal Shah and Group Pharma was invaluable.

This event marks the beginning of sports dentistry in Gujarat. IASD is excited about the potential advancements, innovations in mouthguards and increased collaborations with governmental bodies to ensure every athlete receives the best oral health education and care. The journey will elevate India's sports dentistry landscape and the road ahead for better athlete health and performance is filled with opportunity and excitement.
